

INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT OSCEOLA COUNTY, FL

The population of Osceola County, Florida in 2022 was 422,545, 56.6% up from the 269,841 who lived there in 2010. For comparison, the US population grew 7.7% and Florida's population grew 18% during that period.

Osceola County's population increased 12 out of the 12 years between year 2010 and year 2022. Its largest annual population increase was 4.6% between 2021 and 2022. Between 2010 and 2022, the county grew by an average of 3.8% per year.

In 2022, the largest racial or ethnic group in Osceola County was the Hispanic/Latino group, which had a population of 239,907. Between 2010 and 2022, the Hispanic/Latino population had the most growth increasing by 116,508 from 123,399 in 2010 to 239,907 in 2022.

Between 2010 and 2022, the share of the population that is Hispanic/Latino grew the most, increasing 11 percentage points to 56.8%. The white (non-Hispanic) population had the largest decrease dropping 12.4 percentage points to 28%.

Among six age groups — 0 to 4, 5 to 19, 20 to 34, 35 to 49, 50 to 64, and 65 and older — the 20 to 34 group was the fastest growing between 2010 and 2022 with its population increasing 63.7%. The 0 to 4 age group grew the least increasing 39.8% between 2010 and 2022.
